

## **VOLCAN- literary eruptions**

**Date – January 30, 2012**

### **I. HANGMAN'S HANGOUT**

1. No. of Participants: 04 {02 from class VI-VIII and 02 from class IX-XII}
2. **First / Preliminary Round – Creative Writing Round**
  - This will be Elimination Round.
  - Each team will have to write two creative literary pieces (one by group of VI-VIII and the other by group of IX-XII).
  - Only 6 teams will be selected for the further rounds.
  - Time limit for creative writing is 10 minutes.
  - Topics will be given on the spot by chit system.
  - The participants must bring their pens/pencils and card boards.
  - The decision of judges will be final.
3. **Second Round – 3A -Unmute the Mute (IX-XII)**  
**3B - Story Weaving (VI-VIII)**
  - **3A** -This round will only be for the six teams which qualify the preliminary round.
  - A mute video clipping of 3-5 minutes will be shown to each team. Then the clipping will be re-played and the participants of group IX-XII will be required to super-impose their dialogues in the mute clipping.
  - Pauses or gaps in the presentation will lead to negative marking.
  - Voice modulation and pinch of humour in the presentation will be given extra credit.
  - **3B** – Any member from the group of audience will be called to pick any prop item from a closed carton. The participants will have to begin and continue the story according to the props being shown.
  - One new prop will be shown after the end of every one minute.
  - In all, 5 props will be shown to each team in 5 minutes.
  - Expressions, gestures and spontaneity in the story will be given extra credit.
  - The story should end with a message.
  - Pauses or gaps in the presentation will lead to negative marking
4. **Final Round – 4A –Face –to- Face (conversation based on characters) (IX-XII)**  
**4B – Reframing the Story (VI-VIII)**
  - **4A** -One character will be assigned to each participant of group IX-XII from each team. The characters will be assigned on the spot, on the basis of chit system.
  - The participants will be given time of 5 minutes to prepare the conversation.
  - The conversation will be of duration 3-4 minutes.
  - Expressions, gestures and spontaneity in the story will be given extra credit.
  - Pauses or gaps in the presentation will lead to negative marking.
  - **4B** – A story will be given to the group of VI-VIII on the spot by draw of lots.
  - A time period of 5 minutes will be given to them.

- They will be required to reframe and present the story according to the given instructions.
  - The focus or criteria of reframing of story will be based on vocabulary testing.
  - Pauses or gaps in the presentation will lead to negative marking
- HIGHEST THREE SCORER TEAMS WILL BE AWARDED.

## II. GAHAN ABHIVYAKTI

### Themes:

- **Aazad Desh ke Gulam**
- **Dilli Meri Jaan**
- **Jeene Ka Adhikaar**

- The script of the street play must be submitted on-line/by hand latest by January 25, 2012.
- Language Hindi only.
- Live music only. Use of dholak and Dhaphli is allowed
- White kurtas, jeans and stole should be worn as costume.
- Props according to the requirement.
- Duration: 10-15 minutes.
- No. of participants -6-8
- Class Level –VIII-XI

## III. KAVYA SWARANJALI

### Themes:

- **Main aur mera Mobile**
- **Shiksha mera Janam Adhikar**
- **Phoolon sa bachpan**

- No. of participants - 01
- The poem should be original and in Hindi Language
- The typed or handwritten poem should be placed on the judges' table before recitation.
- Duration: 3-5 minutes
- Expressions, voice modulation and body language will be given due credit.
- Props and costumes according to the requirement.
- Class level – III-V

## IV. SANSKRIT VAARTALAP

- No. of Participants - 2 per team
- Class level –IX-X
- The conversation between the participants will be based on on-the-spot characters
- The characters will be assigned by draw of lots.
- 10 minutes duration will be given for preparation.
- Duration of the conversation should be 3-5 minutes
- Creativity, language, expression and presentation will be given due weightage.
- Assigned characters may be political leaders, actors, cartoon characters etc.

## **ESSENCE – Growing Within**

**Date – January 31, 2012**

### **I. FASHION FIESTA**

- No. of participants -5 per team
- Class level – III-V
- Each participant to represent one state of the country. In all, any five different states of India to be represented in the presentation.
- Focus to be on culture, costume, language, heritage and traditions of the states.
- Presentation may be in the form of dance performances or songs or interactive presentations.
- Costumes and props according to the requirement.
- Duration: 10-15 minutes

### **II. STATE SILHOUETTE**

- No. of Participants – 2
- Class level –IX-XII
- Each participating school has to choose one nation for presentation (excluding India)
- A movie/documentary based on the nation to be submitted on or before January 30, 2012
- Duration of movie: 3-5 minutes
- A two-page (04 sides), A3 size magazine of the nation has to be submitted before the presentation.
- Presentation of the nation's culture, heritage and other developments to be given
- Duration for presentation : 05 minutes
- Total time allotted to each team: 10 minutes

### **III. HOCKEY JOCKEY**

- No. of Participants -2
- Class level –IX-XII
- Video clipping of duration 05 minutes will be shown on-the-spot
- Commentary to be done in English only.
- No obscene language or words to be used.

### **IV. YARNS OF WISDOM**

- No. of Participants -2
- Class level – VI-VIII
- The participants must take up any one moral value and depict a story based on that value on the display board.
- Display board of size 94” X 44” will be allotted to each team.
- The story must be unique and original.
- The story depiction must include a caption also.
- The story depiction must consist of pictures, graphics and dialogues. Pictures and graphics should be made manually. The dialogues must be in English only.

- The pictures, dialogues etc to be put on the board can be bought by the participants. They are just required to display the same on the board at the time of competition.
- Pins will be provided by the host school. Use of adhesive is not allowed.
- Duration – 1 hour.
- The participants may be asked to give presentation of the story and its message. Such presentation has to be in English only.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

1. Registration Time for both the days 8:30 am.
2. Duly filled entry form must be sent latest by January 20, 2012.
3. The schools may give the confirmation of participation by telephone.
4. The participants must come in proper school uniform (or the costumes, wherever required)
5. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
